Dear Rep. Guinta:

The National Military Veterans Alliance, representing 36 military and veterans associations with a combined membership of more than 3.5 million members, writes to express our support for H.R. 4168, the Caring for the Fallen Act, a bill to assign operation and maintenance of the Clark Air Force Veterans Cemetery in the Philippines to the American Battle Monuments Commission.

The Caring for the Fallen Act recognizes the moral responsibility of our nation to honor those who have courageously served our country in uniform. Your introduction of H.R. 4168 demonstrates the nation's highest regard for dignified care of this sacred ground, the final resting place of more than 8,600 American service members, veterans and their families.

As you know, the U.S. government maintained the Clark Veterans Cemetery from 1900 to 1991 until a volcanic eruption caused the closure of Clark Air Force Base and the abandonment of the cemetery. Since that event, volunteers have tried to maintain standards at the cemetery without government assistance.

The National Military Veterans Alliance applauds your attention to care for the dignity these American veterans deserve in their final resting place of honor. We urge your colleagues to approve the bill, and we stand ready to assist in any way possible.
